## Possible activities dedicated to the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary:

- Develop a collection of Conservation Evidence assessments
- Develop a collection of PANORAMA case studies
- Publish a special issue of a scientific journal
- Communication activities

## 1. Develop a collection of Conservation Evidence assessments

- Conservation Evidence Initiative (<https://www.conservationevidence.com>), led by the University of Cambridge, aims to compile, summarize, and disseminate scientific evidence on the effectiveness of conservation interventions.
- **Requirements:** Publications of Conservation Evidence require a robust scientific assessment of the effectiveness of implemented actions.
- **Potential Impact:** Provide valuable insights for practitioners and policymakers, informing evidence-based decision-making in goose management.
- **Audience:** Conservation practitioners, researchers, and policymakers.



## 2. Develop a collection of PANORAMA case studies

- PANORAMA – Solutions for a Healthy Planet (<https://panorama.solutions/en>) is a global knowledge exchange initiative (sharing successful conservation stories).
- **Requirements:** The development of PANORAMA Solutions will require engagement of the EGMP and practitioners in order to propose and draft solutions. Producing a publication will imply costs related to design and printing.
- **Potential Impact:** May encourage knowledge-sharing among stakeholders, replication of the EGMP approach in other regions, and inspire new approaches to goose management.
- **Audience:** Conservation practitioners, policymakers, the general public.

## 3. Publish a special issue of a scientific journal

- Organise, in collaboration with academic partners, a special issue of a scientific journal, such as *Ambio*, focusing on EGMP or a relevant theme related to the EGMP field of work.
- **Requirements:** A special issue in a scientific journal would require prior acceptance by the journal. Thematic proposals for special issues should be negotiated well in advance, usually 12-18 months prior. Would also require strong engagement from the EGMP community to produce manuscripts.
- **Potential Impact:** Enhance the visibility and credibility of EGMP within the scientific community, facilitating knowledge dissemination and collaboration.
- **Audience:** Researchers, academics, and policymakers.

## 4. Communication activities

- **Requirements:** Engagement to produce content (e.g. photos, videos, summaries of scientific publications, quotes, and others).
- **Potential Impact:** Broaden its audience, foster community and citizen science involvement.
- **Audience:** General public, stakeholders.

## Actions requested from EGM IWG9:

- Establish a working group to develop a proposal and workplan for special activities dedicated to the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of EGMP to be presented at EGM IWG10.
