#### Workshop objectives

The workshop's principal objective is to discuss and agree on the necessary elements for a revised draft of the AEWA International Single Species Action Plan for the Conservation of the Taiga Bean Goose, which is foreseen to be submitted to the 9<sup>th</sup> session of the AEWA Meeting of the Parties (MOP9) for adoption in November 2025. To this end, the workshop aims to:

- Provide flyway and national updates on, *inter alia*, the status, trends, distribution, threats and conservation and management issues regarding the Taiga Bean Goose to all participants.
- Review the root causes of the main threats to populations of Taiga Bean Goose, as well as management issues which need to be addressed.
- Review and revise the framework for action (including goal, purpose, objectives, results and actions) of the International Single Species Action Plan (ISSAP), based on the identified threats and management issues.
- Discuss and agree on the timeline and next steps for the drafting, review and completion of the revised ISSAP.
