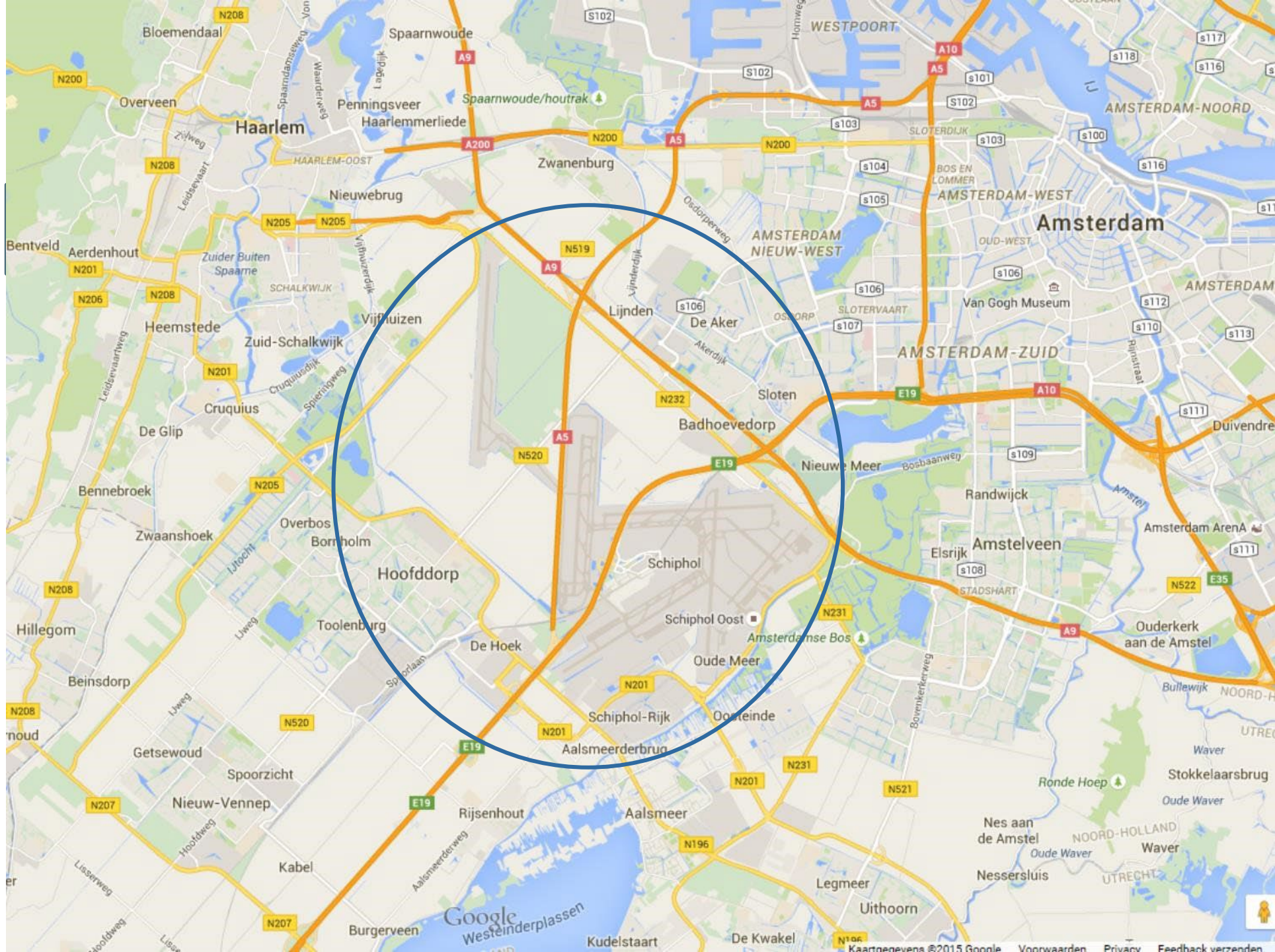

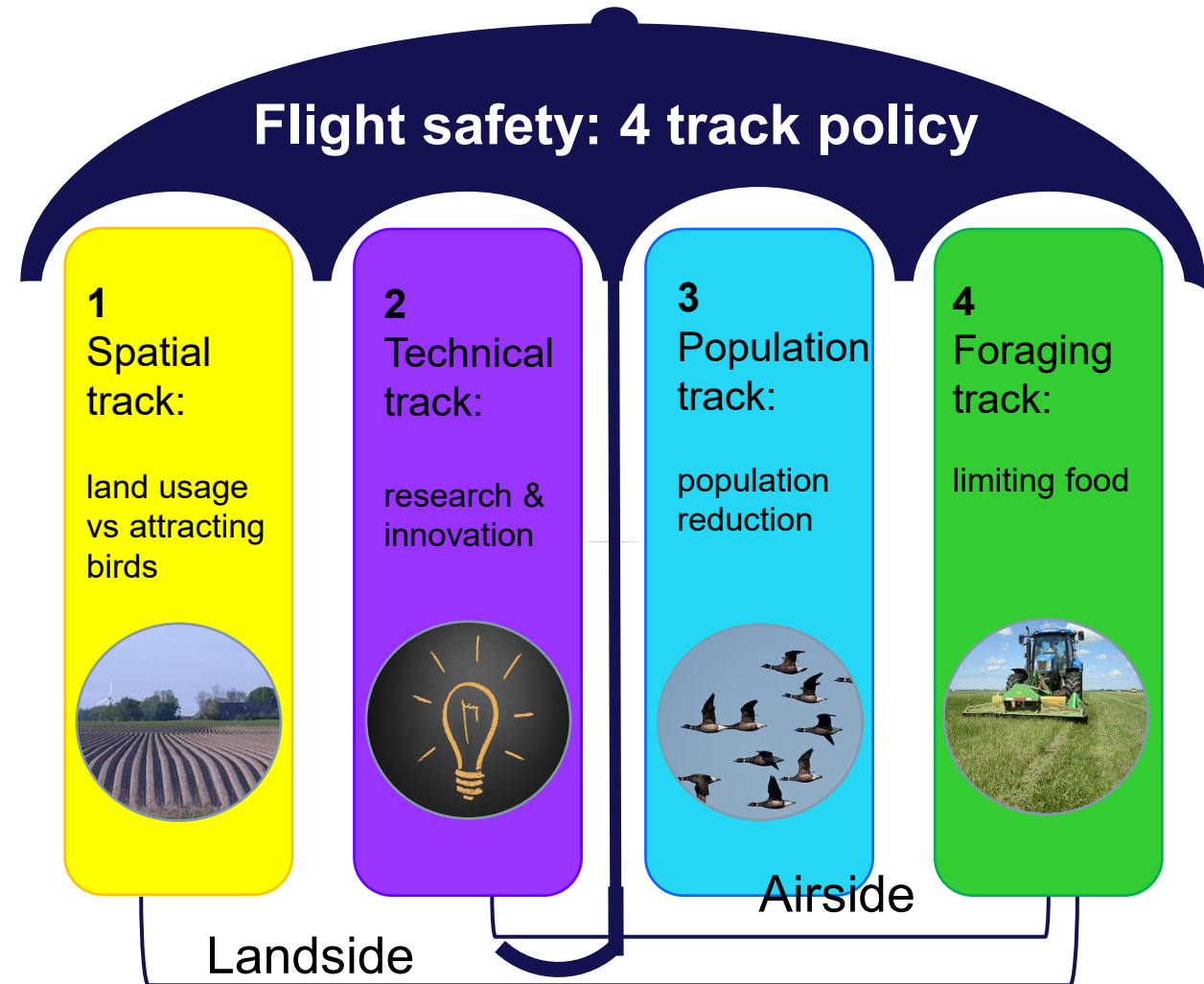








GEESE MANAGEMENT COVENANT

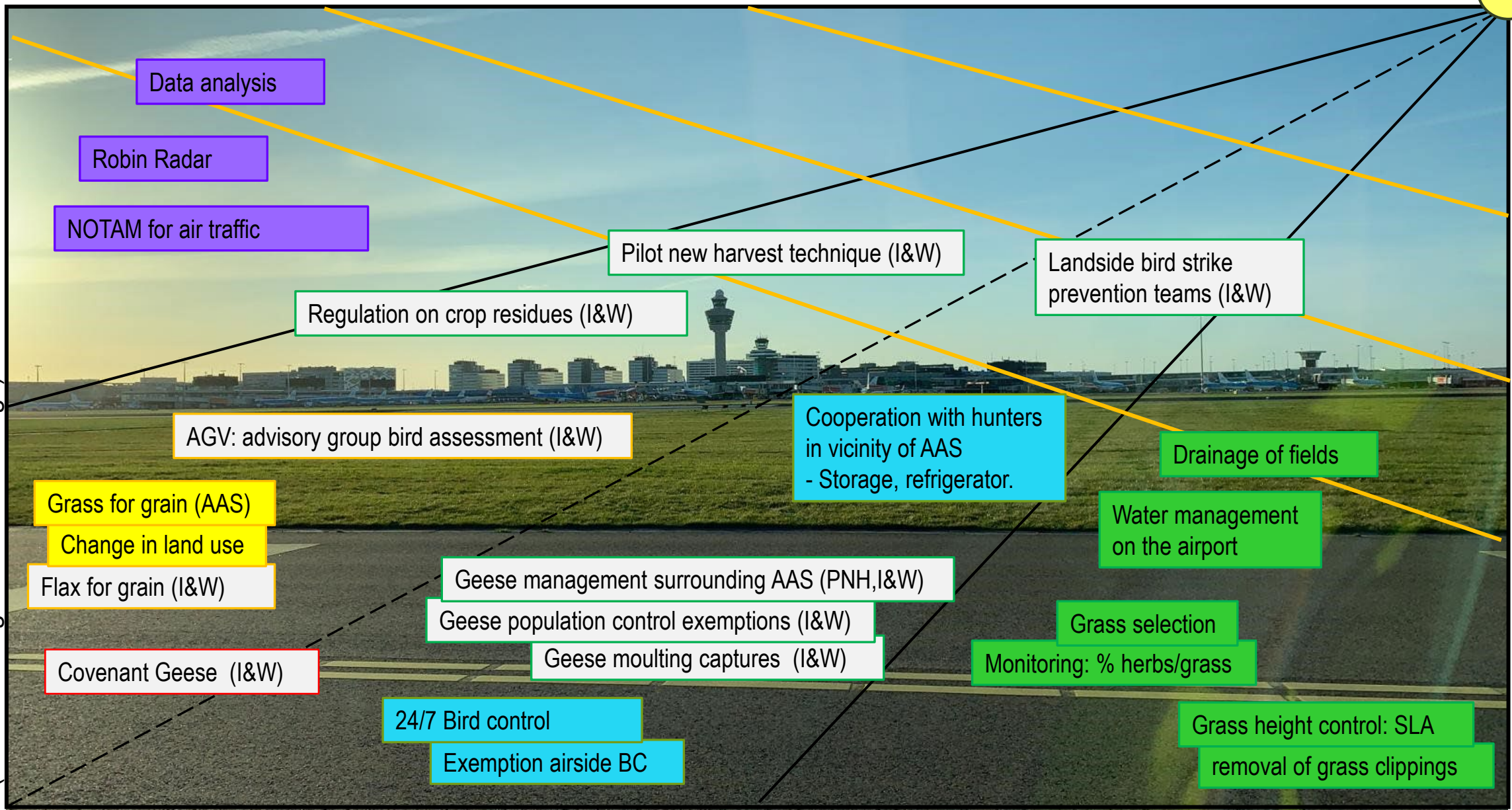

- Airside
 - Removal of grass cuttings
- Landside
 - Grain replaced by grass
 - Rotation crop (beet, onion, potato)
- Guaranteed take-off grass harvest
- Sustainable processing of grass fibers
- Grass panels returned at Schiphol
- Grass panels recycled by processor
