1. Context in which monitoring takes place, i.e. part of governmental scheme, part of a research programme, entirely linked to EGMP management, etc.
2. Organisation of fieldwork, i.e. network of regional organisers, mainly professional counters or volunteers (about how many) or a mix
3. Census scheme as such, i.e. only one-off counts, or monthly counts, etc.
4. Roost counts (evening or morning flights) or daytime counts on feeding sites, or a mix
5. Techniques to overcome gaps in coverage, i.e. imputing, extrapolation/modelling for national totals, addition of non-systematic data like dofbasen or artportalen
6. Other data collected (e.g. age-ratios)
7. Data flow and storage, including timing when data is fully validated and available.

How to get there:

When you arrive in Copenhagen Airport, outside the airport you can take bus 35 to Dragør stationsplads.

Line 35 drives on the route: The airport – The airport East – A.P. Møllers Alle – Dragør stationsplads – Store Magleby – Tømmerup – Amagerhallen – Sundbyvester Plads – Irlandsvej – Dr Byen St.

From Dragør stationsplads there is about 500 m. to the hotel (see map below with a nice walking route).

Tickets cost: You may purchase your tickets from the automatic ticket machines in the arrival halls or directly from the bus driver (but he only accepts cash and in Danish kroner).
